November 17th SDAERC Meeting Recap and Information: Lots of information sharing occurred including the *CAEP PY 21/22 Program Area Report* and the new *PY 22/23 CAEP Member Agency Work Plan and Budgets from both members* submitted to the State CAEP Office. Amertah Perman, SDCCD Dean of Career Education and Workforce Development, shared information about the SDUSD/SDCCD Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that addresses data sharing between member agencies.
