be ousing Commission Affordable Connectivity Program IMPORTANT UPDATE: We were informed by the San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC), Outreach grantee from the FCC for the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) that this program is winding down earlier than anticipated. However, there is hope the Affordable Connectivity Program Extension Act may be adopted but is unknown. Nationally the ACP will run out in April 2024 if additional funding is not provided.

Consumers enrolled will continue to receive their benefit through April 2024. Locally the SDHC has shared that enrollments will cease being taken on February 7th, 11:59pm. While the program may be sunsetting earlier than anticipated, it is clear there is a need. Thank you to Dr. King for providing a letter of support to SANDAG to show local support to Congress for continuing ACP funding. The SDHC will

continue to provide updates to community partners, such as SDCCE, and will determine how to be the best bridge of information to clients.
