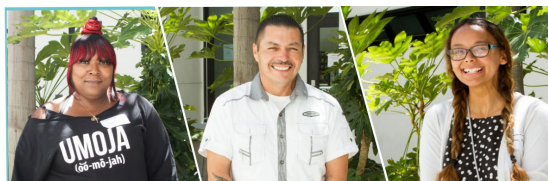
Greetings SDAERC Voting Members and Partners,
