ELIGIBILITY

To participate in Commencement, you must have completed one of the following by June 10, 2023:

- High School Diploma
- High School Equivalency (GED/HiSET)
- Advanced ESL/VESL Program
- Career/Technical Education (CTE) Program of 200 hours or more

Speak with a counselor to review your eligibility and completion of requirements.

Parking at Balboa Park can be challenging. We recommend arriving at the Organ Pavilion no later than 3:30PM on the day of Commencement to allow time to park and get settled. Ample parking is available in the Inspiration Point parking lot, located across Park Blvd via Presidents' Way.
