






## Ethnicity of Continuing Education Students Fall 2014

#### President's 2015-2016 Goals

- **Goal I:** Increase FTES from 8467 in academic year 2014-15 to AY 8575 in 2015-2016 to meet the established District target for student enrollment growth.
- **Goal II:** Work closely with the three Colleges to delineate the role of San Diego Continuing Education in the delivery of developmental skills programming by June 30, 2015.
- **Goal III:** Pursue formal relationship with WIB in the form of two grant applications, alignment of strategic CTE program development at SDCE with the deputy navigator sector pathways, and the development of robust infrastructure around career counseling, job placement, and industry engagement.
- **GOAL IV:** Expand SDCE Career Development College Preparation (CDCP) programming to meet the needs of the community and increase revenue for the District, SDCE students, and local employers in the form of FTES growth during AY 2015-16.
- **GOAL V:** Recruit, support, and retain diverse faculty and staff by program, resulting in an overall increase in the ethnic and racial diversity of CE faculty and staff of 3 percent by June 2016 and 15 percent over five years.
- Goal VI: Collectively develop a 5-year master strategic plan for Continuing Education by May 2016 to launch in July 2016.

## Accreditation Self Study

- The Accreditation Steering Committee formed last fall and continues to oversee development of the Self-Study Report
- Writing teams are working this fall and will continue this spring drafting narratives for the report and including the appropriate data to support these narratives with a rough draft of the report due by the end of November 2015
- Classroom observations are scheduled for this spring and an opportunity to take part in this effort will occur in January 2016
- During November 2015, key members of the Steering Committee will meet with members of the Board of Trustees to address self-study items regarding district governance
- Second draft of Self-Study will be due in late spring 2016
- Third draft of Self-Study will be due in August 2016
- Final copy of Self-Study will be presented to the Board of Trustees in October 2016
- WASC Schools Commission team visit will occur in March 2017
