The second annual *California Community College Noncredit Offerings* survey is being conducted by San Diego Community College District's Continuing Education institution in partnership with Educational Services at California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) to gather information to support noncredit program development and student success. The survey is being <u>sent to all California</u> <u>community colleges</u> to track the development and revision of noncredit programming.
