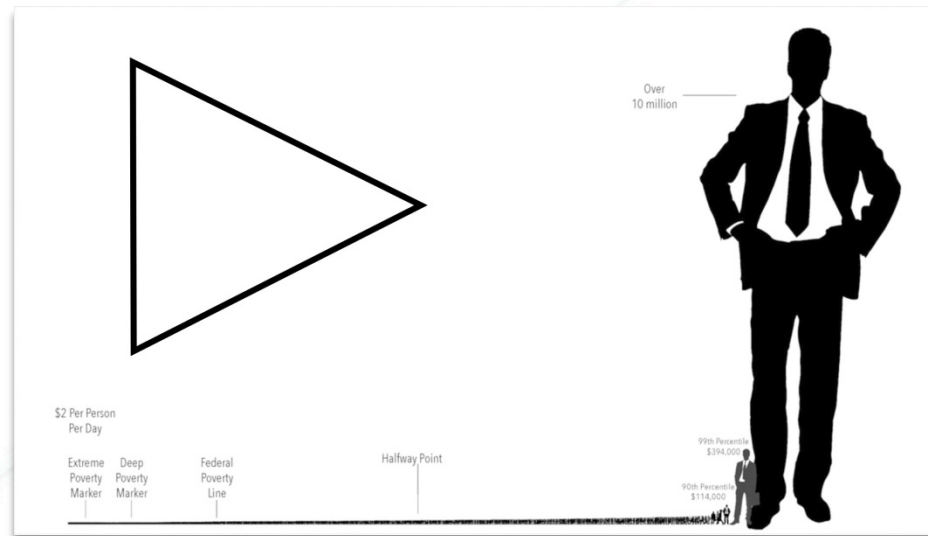

## OFFICE OF THE VICE PRESIDENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES



- Budget Update
  - **Continuous Revenue**
    - \$5.6 million for Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA)*
    - \$2.1 million for Apportionment Funding for Growth*
    - \$6.1 million for Transition to a New Outcomes focused Funding Formula*
  - **One-Time Revenue**
    - \$9.6 million for Deferred Maintenance and Instructional Equipment*
- Pay Raises = 1.1% to 1.6%

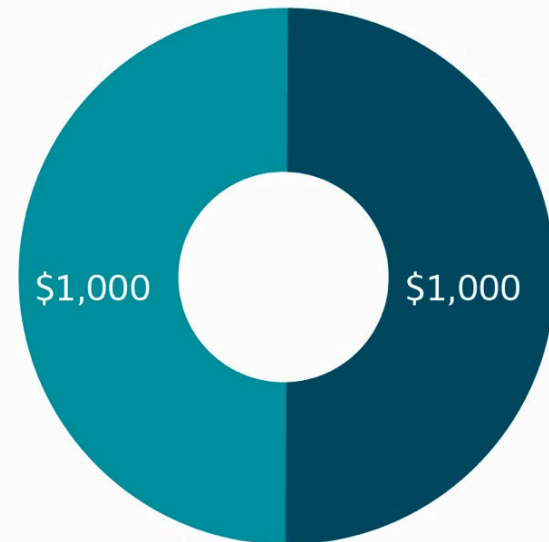
# Employee Giving Campaign
