2020/21 San Diego Continuing Education Research Agenda Overview and Introduction

The purpose of SDCE's Institutional Research Agenda is multi-faceted: to help organize and prioritize research requests, to communicate data and information that is available to stakeholders, to integrate research and college-wide planning and priorities, to encourage data-based discussion and decision making, and to continuously improve the quality of the data and information used on campus.

The research that is included in the research agenda supports the major activities and initiatives that serve the broader functions of the institution (e.g., strategic planning, enrollment management, budget development, program review, accreditation, grant development, Basic Skills, Outcomes and Assessment). They are typically recurring research requests that have clearly defined indicators and metrics attached to them (e.g., student demographics, student completion, number of awards conferred, student or employee satisfaction). To support collaborative inquiry and communication of research, these recurring research requests are organized by theme. However, it is equally important to link the research to SDCE's Strategic Goals (listed as following) and to SDCE's plans and initiatives. Primary end users/responsible groups are also identified, as are hyperlinks if documents are published publically.

- Goal 1: Grow SDCE Programming through increased access and enhanced instructional and student services.
- Goal 2: Cultivate an environment of creativity and increased collaboration both internally and externally.
- Goal 3: Increase student success, academic achievement, life-longlearning, and workforce development.
- Goal 4: Provide SDCE employees with resources and training to increase the quality of instruction and services.
- Goal 5: Strengthen institutional effectiveness through integrated planning and resource allocation.

Research that is narrow in focus or responds to a singular interest or one-time event or activity occur as ad hoc requests that are handled separately using the SDCE Office of Planning, Research, and Institutional Effectiveness (PRIE) research request and prioritization process. PRIE's <u>Request for Research web page</u> provides detailed information to guide stakeholders through the ad hoc research request process.
