



Methodological Consideration


- When using an online survey, students who may not have reliable internet access may be excluded from the data, meaning their experiences and answers go unaccounted for.
- Self-selection Bias Methodological Limitation: Survey participants voluntarily participated in this survey rather than being randomly assigned; thus, there will be differences between the estimates produced by this survey using the sample collected and the actual parameters of the population.

How satisfied are you with the education and training:





Did you use Career Services offered at our college?





How closely related to your field of study is your current job?





What was the main impact that your coursework had on your employment?





What best describes your current employment status:




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Months to Find New Job

How many months did it take for you to find a job:





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


Takeaways

- Students who take courses at SDCCE experience wage increases once they find a job or are promoted at their current organizations. Twenty-three percent more students make \$15 or more per hour than their jobs prior to coursework at SDCCE.
- The split on field of study similarity to the eventual job is near even, with sixty-five percent having a job that is very close or close to the area of study, while the remainder indicated their job is not close at all to their field of study.
- Around eighty-one percent of students state that it took six months or less to find a job, with sixty percent indicating it took between one to six months.
 Similarly, eighty-one percent of students responded they are not seeking a job in another field.

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


Recommendations

Based on the data, PRIE offers preliminary recommendations to be solidified through discussions with SDCCE leadership:

- Creating an internal survey to determine why students go to fields not related to their program of study.
- Continuing efforts to make transitions easier, including additional measures to communicate the options for transitions.
- Explore continuing to develop community-centered internships with local businesses to provide students an opportunity to establish networks and potential future-employment.
