Credit By Exam

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SDCCE to SDCCD Credit College Course Articulation

- ★ Connects existing SDCCE courses to SDCCD credit college courses
- ★ Includes both course alignment and credit by examination
- ★ Faculty-led agreement development

Benefits of Credit By Exam

Benefits May Include:

- ★ Develops collaboration between colleges
- ★ Accelerates credit college degree and/or certificate completion
- ★ Saves students time & money
- ★ Minimizes credit course duplication
- ★ Low risk to student (credit is optional)
- ★ Provides work-based learning opportunities for students

<u>Credit By Exam</u> <u>Process Overview</u>

- Faculty establish Credit By Exam agreement
- Agreement is approved and made effective (usually in Fall)
- Student enrolls in Credit By Exam applicable course*
 - 3.1. Student informed of opportunity to earn credit (may receive information outside of classroom, e.g., orientation)
- Student earns A or B in both the SDCCE course* and Credit By Exam final assessment
- 5. Instructor completes Instructor Certification Form for eligible student within **two weeks** of class end date
- 6. Student is automatically notified of additional requirements, including acceptance of credit
- 7. Student data is verified and eligibility confirmed
- 8. Credit is posted

^{*}Course must be listed in an active SDCCD Credit By Exam agreement.

Signed Active Agreements

Signed active agreements include roles and responsibilities, goals, unique requirements, and pathway information. All agreements are two-year renewable agreements, unless otherwise stated. Instructional Services offices at SDCE and the College each maintain signed copies as well as copies of the agreed upon final assessment. The District also maintains copies of these materials. The agreement renewal process is initiated the fall prior to expiration (if the agreement expires in summer 2021, the renewal outreach will begin fall 2020).

- ★ Be aware of the <u>agreement requirements</u>
- ★ Integrate the approved final assessment (e.g., final exam, final project, portfolio) into the class
- ★ Inform students of <u>Credit by Exam</u> opportunity at the beginning of each class
- ★ Encourage students to complete a <u>SDCCD credit</u> college application at the beginning of the term
- ★ Grade all students participating in the course (final assessment grade and overall course grade)
- ★ Complete the Instructor Certification form for each eligible students within **two weeks** of the class end date
- ★ Complete the Instructor Certification Form for each SDCCE student eligible to receive college credit
