Headcount

The individual count of students, or unduplicated headcount. Cancelled sections and students with less than one attendance hour are excluded. Apprenticeship, fee-based sections, and contract sections are excluded.

FTEF

The total number of adjusted full-time equivalent faculty assigned. Apprenticeship, feebased sections, and contract sections are excluded. F-Factor is not included.

FTES

The total number of full-time eequivalent students enrolled. Apprenticeship, fee-based sections, and contract sections are excluded. F-Factor is not included.

Success

The number of students who receive a passing grade at the end of the term (A, B, C, or SP).

Retention

The number of students who receive a valid grade at the end of the term. It includes students who receive an "I" and return the next time the class was offered receiving a valid grade at their return.

Awards

Depending upon the program reported, course awards may comprise course certificates of completion, while program awards may comprise program certificates of completion, GED certificates, and high school diplomas.

Enrollment

The number of seats enrolled, or duplicated headcount. Cancelled, apprenticship, fee-based, and contract sections are excluded. Drops with 0 attendance hours are excluded.

Sections

The count of classes available for the course.

Productivity

The ratio of FTES by FTEF.

Success Alternative

The number of students who receive a "Satisfied" indication at the end of the class.

Retention Alternative

The number of students who remained at the end of the term.

Fall-To-Spring Retention

The number of students who were validly enrolled in fall and in the spring of the same academic year.

Disproportionate Impact


























