SDCE FLEX DAYS SURVEY Spring 2019

Prepared by: SDCE Office of Planning, Research, and Institutional Effectiveness

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Purpose

One of SDCE's five institutional goals focuses on ensuring that all SDCE personnel have opportunities for professional development: *Goal 4 – Provide SDCE employees resource and training to increase the quality of instruction and services*. Professional development is also one of the ACS WASC visiting committee recommendations for SDCE: *provide equal access to targeted professional development with mechanisms that track and measure impact*. The purpose of the *SDCE Flex Days Survey* is to provide feedback opportunities for faculty, classified professional development activities and events. This report is shared with the Professional Development Committee and executive leaders at SDCE to employ in data-based decisions and planning for future professional development activities and direction.

Methodology

The Flex coordinator partnered with the Office of Planning, Research, and Institutional Effectiveness (PRIE) to conduct a survey evaluating Flex/professional development activities that were offered in Spring 2019.

The Flex coordinator revised the survey instrument in conjunction with the PRIE Office in May 2019. The survey addressed the following items:

- 1) Attendance for Spring 2019 Institutional Day Events
- 2) Satisfaction with Flex/professional development activities

PRIE distributed the online survey between May and June, 2019. Seven hundred faculty members were emailed survey invitations and four reminder emails. A total of 126 surveys were completed (18% completion rate).

This report provides survey response tables and charts, as well as verbatim respondent comments¹.

term classes do NOT get a Flex obligation benefit. Compare this to faculty teaching an 18 week, 13%TAO assignment that does get the Flex benefit. Also, the name should be a Flex benefit, not Flex obligation. STOP THE INEQUITY IN GRANTING FLEX OBLIGATIONS!!! SDCE and SDCCD state they are concerned about student inequity yet they are not concerned about the faculty inequity with the Flex obligations. The way Flex

is interpreted by SDCCD is unjust. Aprrox. 35% of SDCE faculty do not get the Flex obligation benefit. Full time faculty that teach short term classes do NOT get a Flex obligation benefit. Adjunct with 59% TAO assignments with short term classes do NOT get a Flex obligation benefit. Compare this to faculty teaching an 18 week, 13%TAO assignment that does get the Flex benefit. Also, the name should be a Flex benefit, not Flex obligation.
