SDCCE's Enrollment Update Summary

Data as of 11/13/2023

Fall update

Enrollment started for fall 2023 on July 24th. The early registration and enrollment efforts have proven to be positive. Fall classes started on September 5th, 2023, and will end on January 27th, 2024.

SDCCE's overall enrollment for fall stands at 29,613 (12% greater than this time last year, and a 1% increase from last week), with a fill rate of 74%, which is lower than last fall's (80%). SDCCE's overall headcount is currently 15,692, an increase of 14% compared to this time last fall (13,817) and a 1% increase from last week (15,582). FTEF scheduled for the fall semester is 9% higher than last fall (188.82 to 172.98).

Enrollment management efforts continue, with 11% of scheduled sections starting 11/14/2023 or later (107 out of 934).
