## **PURPOSE**

The San Diego College of Continuing Education (SDCCE) asked the Office of Planning, Research, and Institutional Effectiveness (PRIE) to conduct a study with the following objectives:

1. Inform SDCCE's Strategic Planning processes
2. Identify the support SDCCE students need to receive from the institution
3. Assess the prevalence of housing and food insecurity among SDCCE students
4. Measure the perception SDCCE students have in relationship to the institution's enrollments processes, curriculum, staff, and institutional climate

## **METHODOLOGY**

The survey addressed the following research questions:

1. What percentage of the SDCCE students have experienced housing insecurity during the last 12 months?
2. What percentage of the SDCCE students have experienced food insecurity during the last 12 months?
3. What percentage of the SDCCE students consider themselves ready to start attending in-person classes?
4. What kind of support SDCCE should be providing students to help them attend in-person classes?
5. What is the perception SDCCE students have regarding SDCCE's enrollment processes, curriculum, staff, and institutional climate?

PRIE conducted online data collection among SDCCE students throughout April and May 2021. A total of 4,729 surveys were completed.
