## Planning, Research and Institutional Effectiveness

- Completed the Accreditation Mid-Cycle Progress Report for ACS WASC and coordinated a successful visit with participation from 24 administrators, faculty, and classified professionals
- Supported annual strategic planning activities and collected evidence for year four of the seven-year Accreditation Cycle.
- Reported annual progress on the Strategic Plan, Accreditation Action Plan, and Visiting Committee Recommendations.
- Facilitated institution-wide employee planning sessions, student and community need surveys, Planning and Institutional Effectiveness Committee and management meetings in development of new Institutional Strategic Goals and Objectives.
- Conducted a San Diego Adult Education Regional Consortium (SDAERC) survey to gauge effectiveness and accountability and to support the SDAERC strategic plan.
- Developed Annual Integrated Planning (AIP) supports for stakeholders in Canvas, with more than 30 content items and a micro-site on the website to host AIP materials.
- Refined annual program review templates to an "Annual Update" design and to align with accreditation, planning, and resource allocation; and migrated more than 100 PDF reports for Program Review into one Excel-based report for each program, which improved the user experience and reduced workload.
- Developed and implemented a Program Review Writer feedback process that transitioned from a static feedback process to robust live feedback meetings with 100% program/department participation.
- Developed an SLO Assessment survey to collect results at the course and program levels, and an SLO Handbook to explain how to develop SLOs and the assessment process.
- Invested more than 240 hours to support the buildout, testing, and continued data element validation of a new Institutional Researcher Database.

- Supported the District Institutional Research Office in the development of an Enrollment Management Dashboard with disaggregated enrollment information that supports practitioners in scheduling, registration, and roster submission.
- Continued support for the Strong Workforce Faculty Institute by compiling data for faculty; facilitating reflection on data and assessment of student outcomes from an inquiry perspective; and supporting the development of actionable classroom strategies and plans.
- Designed and began conducting a student-centered research project: "Binational Adult Education on the U.S.A. – Mexico Border" that will enable the institution to understand the factors affecting binational students in adult noncredit education and allow practitioners to support binational adult students in their student journey.
- Developed a survey in seven languages (Arabic, Creole, English, French, Somali, Spanish, and Swahili) to study students' satisfaction with the Technology Access Program, which provided laptops to support online learning during the pandemic.
- Developed a survey in collaboration with the Academic and Classified Senates to gain situational awareness of email and internet-related issues experienced by employees.
- Supported the CCCCO Career Technical Education Employment Outcomes Survey (CTEOS) data collection efforts; CTEOS assesses employment outcomes of career education students.
- Supported communication of accreditation, research and assessment activities through the dissemination of three bi-annual newsletters: Accreditation, Office of Planning, Research and Institutional Effectiveness, and The Speedy SLO.



#### Instruction

- Led the programming and continued focus on diversity, equity, inclusion and anti-racism integration into convocation, curriculum development and instructional course development events, committees and processes.
- Exceeded District FTES enrollment targets for the sixth consecutive year and increased individual class section productivity.
- Developed, piloted, and launched a Book Loaning Program to support the transition to remote learning due to the pandemic. The program served over 2,000 students and saved them over \$200,000, plus enabled hard-to-convert programs and students to continue online learning.
- Developed and approved over 50 curriculum items, including five new courses and nine new programs and Implemented over 20 fully online certificate programs through the ICOM Academy
- Developed a faculty mentor and instructional program for distance education course development and integrating new technology and teaching approaches.
- Became a California Virtual Campus Online Education Initiative (CVC-OEI) member and developed a pilot Peer Online Course Review faculty team while leading the development of a noncredit CVC-OEI Rubric with noncredit faculty across the state.
- Created an online repository for Open Educational Resources (OER) at https://sdccd.instructure.com/ courses/2372966)

- Led the planning and submission of \$723,980 in Regional Strong Workforce Projects (SWP) to assist in building innovative new programs, supporting the students' journey, and building capacity to support student success. SWP metrics continue to reflect growth in student outcomes.
- Worked with the San Diego Unified School District through the California Adult Education Program to strengthen communication and collaborative practices for courses information, transitions, and professional development.
- Implemented an online version of the Credit-by-Exam Instructor Certification form in collbaoration with the district office
- Developed sector strategy RFA plans in Healthcare, Sales, Logistics, Advanced Manufacturing, ICT, and Cybersecurity.
- Developed an infrastructure to increase work-based learning in campus and virtual classrooms, and Implemented enhancements to industry advisory boards such as expanding diversity and partnership engagement.
- Collaborated with student services and campus support to provide guidance and support to campus office managers on campus issues related to instruction and student services issues, with a focus on scheduling and operational changes due to the pandemic.
- Received official notification that the Educational Cultural Complex is certified as a smog-training facility.





### **Student Support and Success**

- Digitized over 70 years of high school transcript records for all high school diploma program graduates.
- Coordinated and implemented the Credit-by-Exam electronic process to ensure students will receive college credit for the 35 career education programs that offer this opportunity.
- Coordinated a virtual commencement ceremony to honor 1,100+ students.
- Coordinated scholarships for over 150 students.
- Implemented and transitioned to a new EZText system to connect with 12,947 prospective, current and alumni students, partners, agencies, and groups as identified by programs and departments.
- Successfully recertified programs with Veteran Affairs to allow Veterans to use their education benefits.
- Increased certified Veteran students by 10%.
- Increased community outreach partnerships to 231 community agencies and organizations.
- Updated and redesigned new online presentations and workshops to engage prospective students, current students, and community agencies and partners serving 7,873 people.
- Completed a remodel for The Marketplace at SDCCEats! with store-quality shelving, fresh paint, new lights, new commercial appliances, and a monitor to share recipes, and nutrition guides.

- Completed year one PATHWAYS cohort with a total of 141 homeless students served, 54 employed, over 30 completed a paid internship, and 36 had a positive change in housing. Received an award for year two of the PATHWAYS program to serve homeless students.
- Received an award from the City of San Diego to expand the Technology Access Project and provided 647 laptops and hotspots to low-income students.
- Provided over 1,100 laptops and over 100 hot spots with 6 months prepaid service to students.
- Began the transition to Clockwork software program for Disability Support Programs and Services to seamlessly serve students within the District.
- Increased opportunities for students looking for employment through the Career and College Transition Centers including an increase in employer spotlights by 50%; employer partnerships by 50%; job readiness workshops by 50%; and student engagement increased by 40% and job placements increased by 20%.
- Provided San Diego Promise scholarships to over 35 students.
- Awarded new funding to support the Gateway to College and Careers for ESL/Immigrant/Refugee students.
- Screened more than 200 students for mental health and other anecdotal concerns during the pandemic; provided 85 mental health trainings to 1,224 faculty, staff and students.
- Served 3,613 students served through the Be Well mental health initiative.





#### **Facilities**

- Hosted a Covid-19 vaccine location at the Educational Cultural Complex.
- Completed the SDCCEats! Marketplace location renovation.
- Managed health and safety protocols during the COVID-19 pandemic: including continuously updating policies and procedures, procuring and deploying a personal protective equipment inventory for masks, shields, gloves, and plexiglass.
- Completed the second phase of an exterior wayfinding program at the Educational Cultural Complex and started an exterior wayfinding program at Mid-City Campus.
- Completed improvements in the common areas at the Educational Cultural Complex to support the new historical preservation program.
- Began work on a Facilities Master Plan.
- Installed solar panels at the Educational Cultural Complex.

#### **Finance**

- Managed the general budget to end the fiscal year in a surplus for the first time in over eight years.
- Monitored and accounted for over \$32 million in unrestricted and \$33 million in restricted funding for a total of \$65 million.
- Administered step and educational incentive pay increases for employees.
- Successfully spent \$2.8 million of COVID-19 Relief funding to assist with remote teaching and learning.
- Managed the resource allocation process.
- Coordinated numerous agenda items for Board of Trustee meetings including for the strategy RFA plans in Healthcare, Sales, Logistics, Advanced Manufacturing, ICT, and Cybersecurity.



## **Technology**

- Upgraded a conference room at Mid-City Campus with emergency communications equipment.
- Managed multiple Zoom webinars.
- Distributed 323 laptops, and accompanying webcams, tripods, document cameras, keyboards, monitors, microphones to support employees.
- Planned classroom technology upgrades to 33 classrooms including camera technology at the Educational Cultural Complex, and Mid-City, West City and Cesar Chavez campuses.
- Successfully transitioned multiple business processes into an electronic format.
- Successfully updated the new URL for the San Diego College of Continuing Education website.

### **Professional Development**

- Held an SLO Faculty Exchange Workshop where faculty across disciplines shared best practices in instructional strategies and assessment of student learning, including the liquid syllabus, DSPS accessibility, and badging.
- Organized and promoted SDCCE's inaugural SLO
   Assessment Week to highlight and increase best practices
   in the assessment of student learning.
- Established the Professional Development Advisory Committee for Classified Professionals as a standing subcommittee to plan targeted professional development.
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- Held the first fully virtual Fall Flex Days with keynote speaker Veronica Keiffer-Lewis speaking to "Equity Strong: Reflecting Back/Looking Forward"; 250+ attendees 40+ sessions focused on online teaching skill development, equity-centered sessions, and student support.
- Held Spring Flex with Keynote Rodney Walker speaking to "Mentoring Future Leaders: Turning the Struggles from Today into Strength for Tomorrow"; 300+ attendees and 40+ virtual sessions continued SDCCE's focus on online teaching skill development, equity-centered sessions, and student support.
- Held a series of Virtual Town Hall events (average of 150+ attendees, from many programs, including 75+ faculty and staff) and two President's Forums covering a variety of topics: Compassionate Communication; Cultural Humility, Equity and Transformation; The Community Voice: Courageous Conversations about Education; and Narrative Therapy for Expressions and Healing
- Held many events supporting diversity and inclusion on campus (e.g., African-American History Month Celebration; Disability Awareness Days; Asian-American Week; Black Student Success Week; Women's History Month; LBGTQ SafeZone Trainings; SDCCE Diversity Book Club, Spring 2021; Dreamers Student Sessions and Immigrant Support Sessions; Ability Ally: Supporting Students with Disabilities; and SDCCD EEO & Diversity Trainings)
- Supported the District's Online Canvas Certification, with 291 faculty completed to-date.
- Researched, scripted, produced, recorded, uploaded, and captioned eight TALON videos to support teaching and learning online; 1,309 views by the end of 20/21.
- Conducted Spring Open Educational Resource (OER) Week with 10 sessions focused on equity.
- Held a fully virtual 2021 Classified STAR Conference, with sessions on Cultural Competency, Microsoft 365 Trainings, Team Building Event, Managers Training, Selfcare during the Pandemic (100+ attendees).

#### **SDCE Foundation**

- Received notification of a \$35,000,000 grant from the State of California to support the renovation of the historic theatre at the Educational Cultural Complex.
- Administered a record number and amount of scholarships, awards, and barrier to success grants particularly to address the myriad of needs facing students as teaching and learning moved online during the pandemic. (\$250,000+)
- Received emergency funding from San Diego Community
  Foundation and United Way of San Diego County to
  purchase computers and access to WIFI hot spots for
  students.
- Completed the final year of the first WIOA Gateway to College and Career funding that over the last five years enrolled more than 250 Opportunity Youth of whom 85% successfully completed the program progressing toward furthering their education and into career pathways.
- Expanded Rising to Success Pathways through a \$300,000 partnership agreement with the Lucky Duck and Dana Foundations in support of 150 homeless adults working toward living wage employment.
- Won the Immigrant, Refugee and English Language Learners federal WIOA grant through the San Diego Workforce Partnership to serve Opportunity Youth.
- Won the High Roads Construction Career SB1 grant through the San Diego Workforce Partnership to implement six cohorts of the Apprenticeship Readiness Program that was implemented in 2019 with support from the City of San Diego.

- Won two Community Development Block Grants from the City of San Diego to support Opportunity Youth and to provide computers, WIFI hot spots and digital literacy training to 1,000 students.
- Received the second grant from the trust of former faculty member William (Bill) Rosen.
- Supported the remodel of the SDCCEats! Marketplace through multiple grant funding sources including the County of San Diego.

- Increase faculty support for distance education course design with the implementation of a Faculty Instructional Technologist and Designer.
- Increase teaching modalities with a HyFlex pilot.
- Identify integration points for multiple instructional professional development services (e.g. Distance Education, Passport to Success, Open educational Resources, FELI).
- Build a POCR (Peer Online Course Review) team and process to support SDCCE's membership in the CVC-OEI.
- Explore and plan for an Instructional Services Student Digital Literacy Support program.
- Focus on building community partnerships and relationships through the Office of Instructional Services to increase SDCCE's name recognition; community positioning of noncredit, and new partnership initiatives, that will both grow enrollment and will also lead to increased community impact.
