- **Sprint**, is offering California Community Colleges students a [mobile hotspot service](#), which offers nationwide 4G LTE connectivity and allows users to connect up to 10 WiFi enabled devices for up to 10 hours on a single charge for only \$19.99 a month.
- **AT&T** is providing free access to its [WiFi hot spots](#) throughout the country.
- **Charter** is offering [free Spectrum broadband and Wi-Fi access](#) for 60 days to households college students who do not already have a Spectrum broadband subscription and at any service level up to 100 Mbps. To enroll call 1-844-488-8395. Additionally, all WiFi hotspots are now free of charge.
- **T-Mobile** is providing unlimited data to all current customers who have plans with data for the next 60 days. It will also provide additional data to mobile hotspot users.
