Reports:

- - a. Welcome Tami Foy! This is her first EGC with CE and as the new Executive Director of Foundation.
 - b. Enrollment Figures Overall headcount of 14,101 which is an 8% increase in comparison to last spring. We also have a current fill-rate at 67%
 - c. 3597 was the goal, but we are currently at 4103.09 FTES, our goal is around 8000, but we are on track to
 - d. Facilities Bond Priority Projects for the district. We have 60 project items on our roster, but our public listed four are: Upgrading Welding shop at ECC, Auto Body Lab at ECC, Upgraded CE Centers, Child Care Centers
 - i. EPO team will send the Facilities Bond and CE Priorities documents to EGC members
 - ii. Also looking for additional dining spaces for all CE campuses.

- iii. We will get the surveys for it in June and then voted on in November.
- iv. It depends on the general public opinion, and so we need to put the topics that the public would most vote for.

 - a. Thank you for the EPO team for putting together the AS/CS Dinner.
 - b. Excited to talk about the bond with the district and the eventual developments of the college.
 - c. The senate is grateful for the collaborations with the college and Institution Day

Richard Weinroth to propose on Work Based Learning, Employment readiness pivoting from life skills focus, and Language the workplace in the classroom.

 - b. Looking at Professional and Faculty web development.
 - c. Microsoft A5 Adjunct software that can requested via the Dean.
 - d. SDCCD Professional Learning Hub on site to assist all members to learn.
