It is increasingly important in the uncertain and transition pandemic world of higher education for adult learners. SDCCE recognized this issue is at its core one of social justice and equity. Ongoing, multi-faceted, and holistic student support is crucial for disconnected adult learner populations that face many personal and societal barriers.</p> <p>Considerations: How many students were lost or have not been able to engage due to DEI gaps in services; how to address the needs holistically across our institution; disaggregating the data to discern which students are most impacted by the digital divide; which students are we missing; access to computers.</p> <p>Big Ideas: Digital needs assessment tool; digital literacy learning platform; digital equity learning/tutoring labs; digital literacy workshop and/or course; expand digital literacy Career Development College Preparation (CDCP) Instructional Program Certificates; Technology Access Project (TAP); City of SD's Digital Navigator Program; Community Partnerships; Advocacy.</p> <p>Summer 2022 Project Focus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Timeline: July & August • Identify existing DEI programs- Collect quantitative and qualitative data to identify best practices and lessons learned. • Internal Outreach- What are we already doing at SDCCE?
