## **Reports and Recommendations:**

1) **President's Report:** President Beebe reported that Continuing Education's prorated share of the District's budget reduction for this year is approximately \$452,900. At the previous EGC meeting, Dr. Beebe requested members to send suggestions of ways to arrive at this figure to the Budget Committee for consideration in preparing a plan.

#### Recommendation:

### 1.1 CE Budget Reductions: Recommendation from CE Budget Committee

Bob Parker brought forward the following recommendation:

On Monday, December 8, 2008, the Continuing Education Budget Committee convened to develop a plan to reduce Continuing Education's Budget. In the development of this plan, the Committee reviewed the Chancellor's Special Update Regarding the State Budget email sent out on November 26<sup>th</sup>. They also took into consideration reductions should primarily come from non-classroom activities at this time. The Committee passed the following recommendation:

#### To reduce the Continuing Education Budget for 2008-2009 by:

- 1) Not filling the Dean vacancy transfer certain expenses to Community Ed.,
- 2) Not filling identified Classified vacancies transfer certain expenses to Community Ed.,
- 3) Reduce Faculty Release Time by 1.0 FTEF;
- 4) Reduce Adjunct Counseling; and
- 5) Utilize increase in 231 funding.

These reductions are spread across Administration, Classified, Faculty and Discretionary and total the prorated amount of \$452,900, CE's share needed at this time.

# **Disposition of Recommendation:**

1.1 Continuing Education Budget Reduction: M/S/P Mosteller/Ellison EGC unanimously recommended to the President to accept the Continuing Education Budget Reduction Plan as presented by the Continuing Education Budget Committee.
