a) PY 24/25 Consortium Fiscal Administrative Declaration (CFAD) & Preliminary Allocation • 10 Year CAEP Allocation Trends • AB 1491 Carry Over Compliance Overview b) CAEP Out of State Travel c) Annual Meeting Calendar PY 24/25	PY 24/25 Consortium Fiscal Administrative Declaration (CFAD) & Preliminary Allocation, Kelly Henwood, Special Projects Manager, Consortium Director, SDCCE - Explanation of the CFAD and due date was provided. The CFAD divides the allocation given to SDAERC between member agencies and consortium state assurances and governance agreements. - The CFAD has a hard deadline to submit to the state of 5/2 at 5pm. - The current and historic allocation split between the two SDAERC Member Agencies since inception of AEBG has been 25% SDUSD and 75% SDCCD - All state Consortia are in Year 1 of the two-year AB 1491 carryover compliance legislation. If the consortia have "excessive carryover", more than 20%, for two years in a row they will be placed under corrective action by the state CAEP. - At the previous SDAERC meeting on March 21st, the SDAERC was unable to come to a vote due to a request to increase the SDUSD allocation from 25% to 30%. At that time, SDCCE requested more time to analyze projected expenses. - At this special meeting, Member Agency SDUSD Adult School again requested an increase to the percentage of their allocation again from 25% to 30%. - SDUSD is requesting the increase in their CAEP allocation percentage to accommodate salary increases at SDUSD as a district which increased personnel costs by 15% across the board as well as to maintain CAEP programming. - SDCCE VP of Administrative Services, Jacqueline Sabanos, requested that

- additional time be given to conduct a more thorough financial analysis to see the implications of these cuts to SDCCE.
- It was suggested that perhaps a one-time transfer of funds could be requested in the future if a new allocation split is not approved for the PY 24/25 CFAD.
- Dr. King requested a full financial analysis be done. On top of this, the additional funding may be needed by SDCCE for the current reorganization process that SDCCE is going through. Dr. King remains open to revisiting the CFAD next year (PY 2025) with analysis. Dr. King said she is keeping the possibility of another one-time transfer of funds open for PY 24/25.
- Nate Sachdeva, SDUSD, mentioned SDUSD will be financially stable through the next PY 2024. However, the following year, PY 2025, will be where cuts will affect SDUSD Adult School.
- SDUSD is not seeking the increase to maintain their program given the raises and budget cuts.
- M/S/C To approve the CFAD as is Rachel/Nate/ Approved by consensus

CAEP Out of State Travel, Rachel Rose, Department Chair, Child Development, SDCCE

- Rachel is requesting approval for out of state travel for The Summer Dance Institute for Teachers (SDIT) in Seattle.
- CAEP funds are being requested for travel funding which Perkins and Academic Senate cannot supplement.
- Approximately \$1,263.43 of CAEP funds are being requested
- Will benefit CAEP instructional program CTE Child Development
