- SDUSD Process: Students enter dept and any open hours of operation.
- They have the option to work independently or in a classroom, and enrollment occurs on a rolling basis
- SDCCD Connection through HISET and Gateway paths
- Students are loaned chromebooks
- Average time for diploma completion 1.03yr compared to 2yr in 2019-2020
- Noticeable aspects from research:
 Pre-algebra added to math curriculum, econ credit available,
 Special Needs students entering with more experience from K-12,
 AM-Lit soon to be added, vast enrollment/graduation rate improvements since COVID
- SDCCE: Process
- HSDP served 18-23, HSEP: 21-23
- HSDP Harsh drop in student population since COVID
- HSEP Slight increase since COIVD
- Pandemic increase certificate completion rates in HSEP/HSDP
- Options in fully online, high flex, fully in person, and half in person half online
- Important notes: No middle school needed to enroll in HS programs
- Regional data: 93,526 Adults age 25+ with no secondary school degree
